Health Care Home (HCH) is a way of delivering health care. HCH is not a building, house, hospital or nursing home; it's a team approach that supports your care. The team includes you, your primary care provider, other healthcare providers and staff at the Mankato Clinic.

How can a Health Care Home help you?

- At Mankato Clinic, you'll build a relationship with a trusted health care provider who will lead your medical team and watch over your care to help you reach the best health possible.
- Your team will be there to answer your calls and questions, remind you about check-ups and tests, and coordinate your care with specialists.
- Your team will make certain that you receive the right care, when you need it.

What is Health Care Home?

Mankato Clinic is certified by the State of Minnesota as a Health Care Home (HCH). A HCH is a way of delivering health care. HCH is not a building, hospital or nursing home; it's a team approach that emphasizes coordination of care by organizing timely access to the resources and necessary care. This team-based effort promotes the prevention and management of chronic illnesses. Your care team anticipates your health care needs and works to coordinate care that will meet your individual needs. Much of this work is done behind the scenes before and after your visits to the clinic. The team includes you, your primary care provider, other healthcare providers and staff at the Mankato Clinic. Patients receiving primary care services at the Mankato Clinic are members of our HCH. Certified HCH clinics in the state, including the Mankato Clinic, have achieved higher patient satisfaction and better patient health outcomes, while demonstrating healthcare cost savings.

What is the role of the patient and family?

You and your family are experts about your needs and are valued members of the HCH team. When patients/families are at the center of the HCH team, health outcomes and quality of life are improved.

- Help set your own health goals.
- Communicate back to your team about meeting your goals.
- Notify your team if you have a change in your health condition.
- Notify your team if you had a hospitalization or emergency room visit.
- Know what medications you take.
- Participate in all decisions about your treatment and the health care services you receive.
- Talk openly with your team. If you feel your care plan is not working, discuss it with your care manager or HCH team, so changes can be made together.

What if I have complex medical needs?

Patients with complex medical conditions may benefit from having an RN Care Manager. The RN Care Manager will:

- Support communication between you, your healthcare provider and your nurse team.
- Assist you in creating a plan of care and lifestyle goals.
- Coordinate care between healthcare providers and specialists.
- Provide education and information related to your needs.
- Connect you and your family to community resources.
- Help with transitions of care between hospital and home.

Is there a cost?

If you have one or more chronic health conditions, you will see a Health Care Home maintenance monthly charge on your account (ranging from \$11 to \$60). The charge is based on the level of services and coordination required for your care. Most insurance companies cover these charges because these companies recognize the health benefits and costs savings that are possible through the HCH model of care. Government provided health insurance plans such as Medicaid also cover these charges.
