EMERGING SKILLS DURING AGE RANGE

- Understands opposites
- □ Follows 2-step directions
- □ Understands new words quickly
- □ On average, uses 50-250 words
- □ Has a word for almost everything
- □ Speech is 75% intelligible or understood by familiar listeners
- □ Can identify pictures of familiar objects
- Identifies body parts and clothing
- □ Puts 3 words together
- □ Asks questions
- □ Engages in turn-taking with peers
- □ Stacks blocks 4-6 high
- □ Turns pages of a board book one at a time
- Colors more in smaller areas of a picture, but still out of the lines
- Completes block puzzles
- □ Throws a ball towards a target
- $\hfill\square$ Kicks with improved form and direction

Developmental Toys & Activities

- → Encourage words rather than just gestures/pointing
- → Give your child choices, allowing them to communicate and to be in control
- → Do puzzles together, take turns identifying the puzzle piece
- \rightarrow Art projects
- \rightarrow Mr. Potato Head
- \rightarrow Pip Squeak markers or smaller markers to color
- → Small or broken crayons to promote pincer/tripod grasp
- \rightarrow Playdoh
- → Pretend play toys: kitchen/food, doctor kit or baby dolls
- → Different size outdoor balls to play catch or to learn to kick
- \rightarrow Simple flash cards that has colors, shapes or letters
- \rightarrow Duplo blocks or Magnatiles
- \rightarrow Barn with farm animals
