EMERGING SKILLS DURING AGE RANGE

- Understands words for common items and people, for example: mom, cup, milk, cracker
- $\hfill\square$ Understands simple commands, for example: no, come here
- $\hfill\square$ Answers to their name
- □ Points and shows objects to others
- Uses gestures like waving and shaking their head "no"
- Imitates different sounds
- Increases the number of words they are saying as they reach
 1 year of age
- □ Grasps objects with thumb and index finger to pick them up
- Bangs two toys together
- Clasps their hands together
- $\hfill\square$ Crawls on their hands and knees
- Gets into sitting position alone
- $\hfill\square$ Pulls themselves up to stand
- $\hfill\square$ Puts toys in container and takes out to play
- $\hfill\square$ Turns pages of a book
- □ Cruises along furniture
- $\hfill\square$ Begins to use a spoon
- $\hfill\square$ Stands alone for a few seconds
- □ Crawls up the stairs

Developmental Toys & Activities

- \rightarrow Patty Cake or finger play songs
- \rightarrow Read books
- \rightarrow Place ball under torso while practicing crawling
- \rightarrow Piggy bank toy to put coin in and out
- \rightarrow Place toys on furniture to encourage cruising
- \rightarrow Musical books or touch/feel books
- → Rattles, keys and other toys that shake and make noise
- → Simple shape sorter to put in and manipulate blocks
- \rightarrow Offer simple spoon to encourage self-feeding
- \rightarrow Toys with buttons to push for sounds or lights
